

HOW TO: Amend the Whitehill Allotment Society Rules

We have two sets of rule (i) the 'Bye-laws', which are the rules distributed to the Membership. (ii) the 'Registered Rules' which are registered with the Financial Conduct Authority. The most recent version of these can be downloaded from <https://mutuals.fca.org.uk/Documents/Download/147182>

The procedure for changing the rules is different for each of these

The Bye-Laws

1943 Bye-laws, Clause 29
(the 2020 Bye-laws do not address this issue)

Amendment of By-laws

No amendment of these By-laws shall take effect until it has been sanctioned by a General Meeting of the members due notice of the proposed amendment being given in the notice convening the meeting.

Registered Rules

Registered Rules, Clause 58

Mode of Amending Rules -

The Rules may be amended by a resolution of a three-fourths majority at a Special General Meeting. No amendment of rules is valid until registered.
